# Adams Central History

- July 29, 1966 election held, 70% of patrons favor creating a new district
- July 1, 1967 effective date of new Adams Central District
- Contracted students for the 1967-68 school year while building was built
- School started on Sept. 3, 1968 with 260 students 7-12
  
- In 1968, there were 11 class I Districts feeding into Adams Central
- By 2006, there were 5 class I Districts feeding into Adams Central
  
- In 2006-07 became a NEW district, a Class III District
- In 2011-12 the Ayr and Tri-View Elementary schools were closed
